GABE'S CHEMO DUCK PROGRAM: Lion Barbara Gavin continues to make presentations and receive checks throughout the Mid-Hudson Valley. 36 Gabe's Chemo Ducks were sent to the Melodies Center for Cancer and Blood Disorders in Albany. On April 19 District Governor Joyce Maier and Lion Barbara Gavin formally presented the ducks and a certificate to the Melodies Center. After the presentation a tour of the inpatient facility took place. 54 Gabe's Chemo Ducks were sent to the Maria Farerri children's Center in Westchester. A formal presentation of the ducks and a certificate is being worked on at this time. The Maria Farerri Children's Center also received 54 of the 72 ducks given to Vassar Brothers Hospital last year. Both facilities received the 1 years request to fulfill their needs. We hope to continue to supply these 2 facilities to ensure children of the Hudson Valley receive them.
